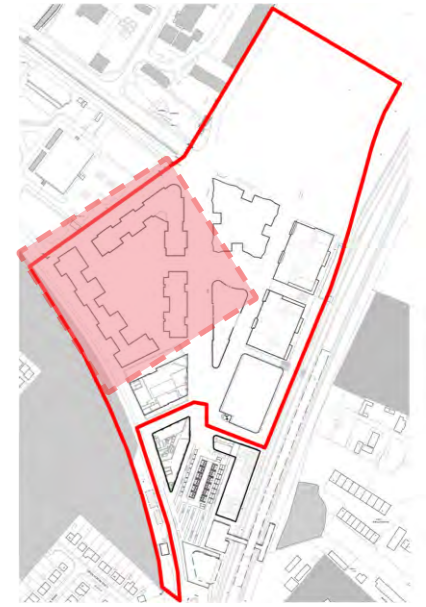


# LANDSCAPE AND OPEN SPACE

## RESIDENTIAL OPEN SPACE: CHESTERTON GARDENS

The residential gardens offer an extensive tree-filled green space, with both open lawn spaces for sunning and passive recreation, and more intimate areas for quiet conversation and contemplation. Play provision includes both a Local Equipped Area of Play (LEAP, 400m<sup>2</sup>) and a Local Area of Play (LAP, 100m<sup>2</sup>) but also natural play opportunities that double as seating for adults and young people. Pergola with picnic tables and growing spaces contribute to a sense of place.

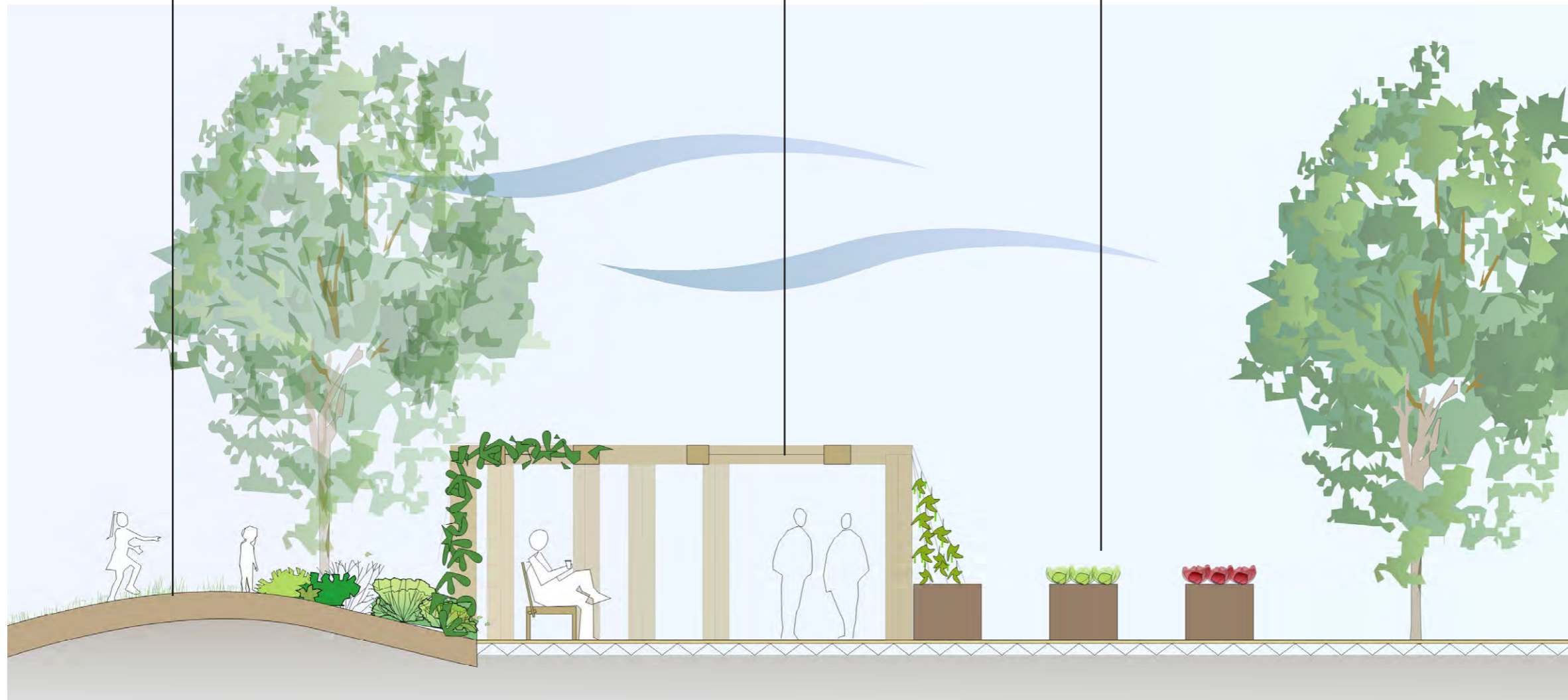

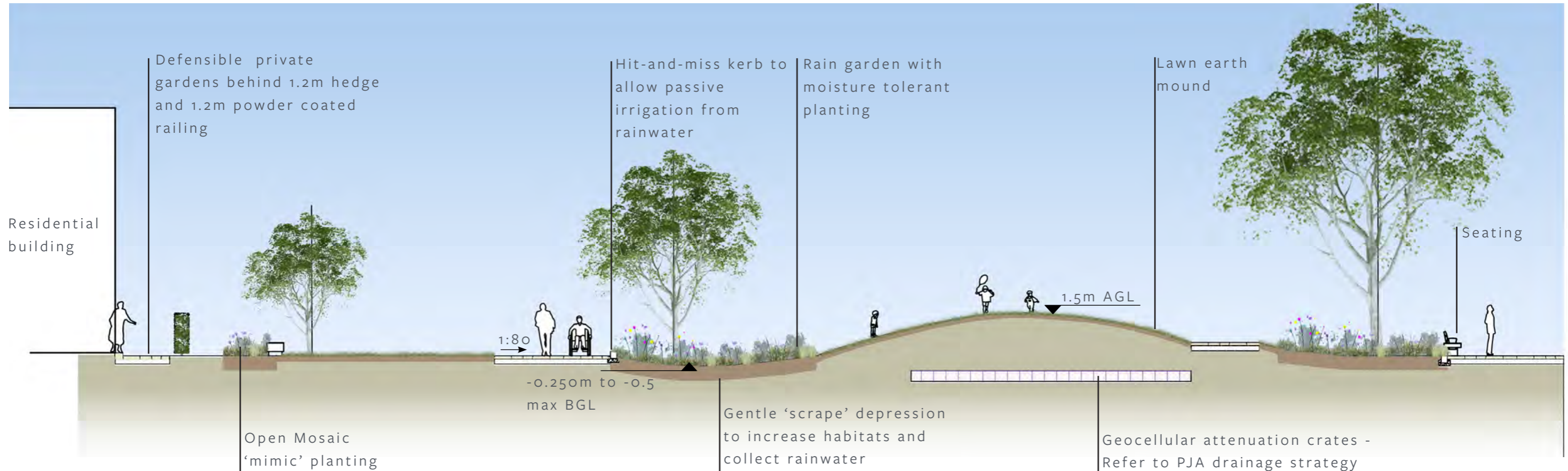
