
The pavilion has recently been refurbished.

Summary (Great Shelford)

The village has one recreation ground with a junior football pitch, senior pitch, cricket square, bowls green, play area, youth facilities and four hard floodlit tennis courts. There is a rugby club in the north of the village.

Great Shelford Parish Council have secured funding for the new Sports Pavilion and this is currently under construction with total project cost of £487315

The village also has a rugby club which has excellent facilities owned and run by the club. There are 5 pitches taking up approximately 12 acres, the club have many teams both men and women and girls and boys. The land owned by the Rugby Club has not been included as part of the final figures for Great Shelford as it is a commercial facility.
