Sawston – Stapleford (Cambridge)	Unsegregated Pavement	A cycle link between the edge of Stapleford and the edge of Sawston running along Cambridge Road. The cycle route breaks through Stapleford and Great Shelford picking up again and heading into Cambridge.
Sawston – Whittlesford (Sawston Parish Council)	Dedicated off road route	Whittlesford Church to A1301 Sawston bypass, Spicers Entrance. From there, on road unsegregated via Mill Lane to centre of village or Mill Lane/New road to Sawston Village College.
Sawston – Whittlesford Parkway Rail Station (Sawston Parish Council)	Off Road and Unsegregated	Whittlesford Parkway Rail Station to A505/A1301 junction off road. From there, on road unsegregated via London Road Pampisford/Sawston and High Street, Sawston to centre of village.




