OVERVIEW

Background

- The e-scooter trial in Cambridge has been running since October 2020 with e-bikes joining the fleet later in 2021
- In January 2024, the DfT contacted trial areas giving them an opportunity to seek changes to the boundary and/or fleet size of their existing areas
- An application was made by the Combined Authority in April 2024 to increase the geography and fleet size to capture new developments and adjacent villages.
- Dft approved the application late last year.

Strategic Fit

The Local Transport and Connectivity Plan (LTCP) commits the Combined Authority to reduce road traffic by 15%. To achieve the ambitions within the LTCP will require the Combined Authority to offer a choice of sustainable modes of transport. E-scooter and e-bike expansion form part of that approach.

Reporting issues: 'Report-A-Voi'

We warn, strike and sanction users who flout the rules. Users and non-users can report any instance of antisocial behaviour through the Report-a-Voitool.

1. Identify

Each vehicle is kitted with number plates on the front, back and sides, providing 360° visibility to support reporting by the public and authorities.



2. Report

Report-a-Voi (report.voi.com) and our hotline allows users, non-users and third parties to report issues, inappropriately parked, faulty/defaced or anti-social user behaviour of Voi scooters.
