
Summary

The village of Thriplow has a cricket ground and pavilion, which has been purchased from the landowner for the cricket club. The club have improved both the pavilion facilities and practice facilities with Astro turf nets in 2009 at a cost of £24575.

The recreation ground committee are carrying out a regeneration project on the recreation ground during 2011/12 to include a new play area.

Although there is a football pitch in Heathfield the village players go to nearby Fowlmere. Cricket players living in Fowlmere go to Thriplow to play.

There is a cricket club using the facilities with both adult and junior teams.
