
**Summary**

The village has one recreation ground with a senior pitch, two mini soccer pitches, a cricket square, two hard tennis courts and play area.

The pavilion is in good condition with two changing rooms, official's room and meeting area.

There are cricket and football clubs in the village with both adult and junior members; there is also a tennis club.

The tennis courts were resurfaced in 2007 costing £13525 and also in 2007 £6681 was spent improving the play area
