**Summary**


The recreation ground is well situated between the two villages and is used by 2 football and 2 cricket teams.

A second community orchard/open space is proposed in Great Eversden on plot known as OSP 148 as part of a provision of affordable houses. If the scheme is approved Parish Council has agreed to maintain it.

£26,000 was raised for a children's play area a few years ago. A new fence and equipment was installed and is well used.

A shelter/meeting point has been given to the Recreation Ground and this has been installed.

The only indoor play area is Eversden Village Hall which is used for table tennis
