

Summary

This small village has no formal outdoor sport facilities. There is one small formal playspace north of Church Road included in the Village Garden. In January 2005 it was identified by a local group, the need for a hard surface football play area for the young people of the village. The PC included this as an action to investigate as part of the Village Plan as part of any new housing development. New play equipment was installed in 2007 with £2300 funding from SCDC towards a £4425 project.
