Summary


The village has one recreation ground with a football pitch, cricket square and bowls green.

Coton Cosmos FC have been developed to provide opportunities for young people to take part in football.

The skate park was being removed in 2012 due to damage.

The Parish Plan identified an aim to form a tennis club and seeking funding for tennis courts.

Coton as part of the joint vision for Cambridge's quarter to six quadrant has identified the need to enhance the sporting features and playing fields in the area whilst keeping to the existing features of predominantly playing fields with only small pavilions and no large construction.
